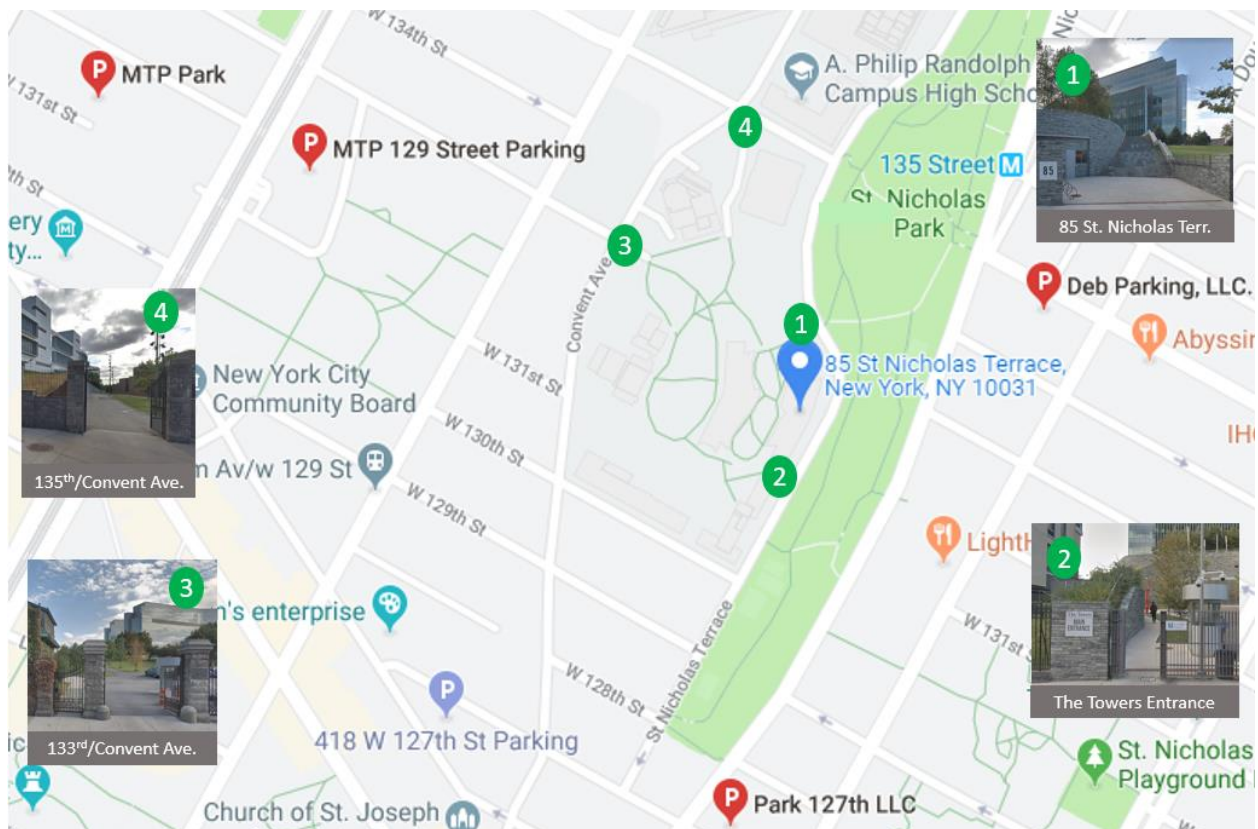


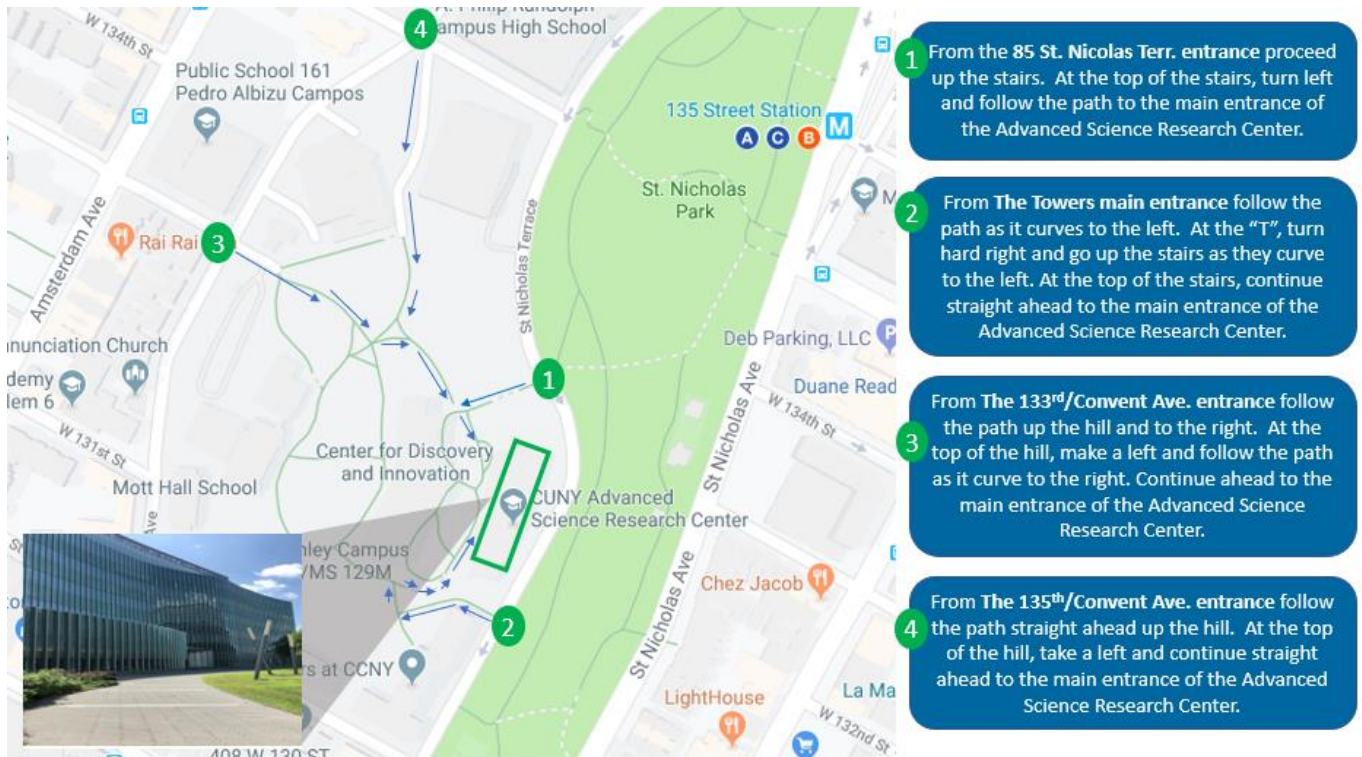
The CUNY Advanced Science Research Center (ASRC) is in Harlem **at the southeast corner of the historic and scenic City College of New York campus**, located at 85 St Nicholas Terrace. The building sits between The Towers main entrance and 85 St. Nicholas Terrace entrances. The campus is situated atop the impressive rock cliffs of St. Nicholas Park between St. Nicolas Terrace and Convent Avenue, and 130th and 141st Streets.



Not far from our Harlem Evaluation Center, the campus is **under an hour's drive from most points in all five boroughs of New York City** and many locations in the greater metropolitan area too. There are **a number of parking options near the campus**. None offer parking

validation, but the cheapest – MTP 129 Street – is only \$12 for up to 12 hours. Other prices are about \$25 for more than 2 hours or \$15 for the day if you arrive before 10 am.

To get to the Advanced Sciences Research Center (ASRC) building once you arrive at the campus, first identify your entrance based on the area map and entrance photos above. Find the matching entrance and direction block on the map below, and follow the paths with the arrows to the main entrance of the ASRC.



Enter the Advanced Science Research Center building and make a sharp left into the café. **Call the MRI team at 347-835-9943 to let them know you have arrived.** A member of the Healthy Brain Network MRI team will greet you to bring you to the MRI Suite.
